



Here are a few questions you may wish to ask at the Career Showcase events you visit:

1. What kind of education or training will I need to be successful in this career? How long will it take to complete the training or education?
2. What classes and/or training do you recommend taking during high school to help prepare for this profession?
3. What is the future outlook for this profession? Is there upward mobility? Can I be sure of finding employment if I should move out of state?
4. What is the salary range for this career field? How does that differ across the state and/or nation?
5. What benefits might be included with employment?
6. What type of hours are expected? What about the schedule for evenings, weekends, and holidays? Is there any flexibility?
7. Do people in this profession work alone or with other people?
8. Are there special needs for this profession such as uniforms or personal equipment?
9. What are the most enjoyable things about this profession? Least enjoyable? Is the work demanding, stressful, or routine?
10. How much responsibility comes along with this career? How much authority does the position offer? What about the accountability of this position?
11. What about high school attendance and academic performance? How do these affect potential employment in this profession?
12. If I'm interested in pursuing a career in this area, where should I go from here?
